THE CHILDREN SCHOOLING AND FEEDING CENTERS MINISTRY

Dear friends and ministry partners,

As we are getting closer to the end of this year, Marie and I want to thank God for his grace in protecting the staff and the children of our Feeding Center in Hatt from a propane gas accident. The Hatt community is where we have a church building that had collapsed during the January 12, 2010 earthquake. During this past month, we realized that our 100lbs propane gas tank in the kitchen was finished in less than a month while it had usually works well past four weeks. Assefie, our cook had been complaining of a strange odor every time she was cooking.

By the grace of God, last week we decided to inspect thoroughly the rubber tube which runs from the stove inside to the gas tank set outside, we then found out that it was leaking gas badly due to rats' bites. God was gracious and prevented us from a possible tragic accident which could have endangered the life of the cook, the teachers and the children in the Center. We give thanks and praise to God for His mercy lasts forever.

We also thank God for the fact that we were able to care for the children in our School and Feeding Center in Pernier and our very needy kids in our School and Feeding Center in Leogane. It is reported that Haiti has about 1.5 million children; over half of them do not go to school. Moreover, only 35 % of Haitian children reach 6th grade, the rest drop out of school due to financial hurdles for Haiti's mostly private school system.

In this school year, the new Haitian President vowed to sponsor the schooling of 100,000 children. This is a good initiative from the government, however those children will not receive any bible based education; and how about those who are still unschooled and malnourished and could easily die before their teenage years?

I praise God because through your monthly supports He has granted us the privilege to feed, school and provide Bible based education to the children in our 3 schools and feeding Centers, 5 days a week and all year around. Thank you very much!

In closing Marie and I would like to thank you especially for your donation, if you did, to help restore our School and Feeding Center buildings for the New Year and buy toys for those children and our children churches for Christmas. We would like to wish you from the bottom of our hearts:
