Dear coworkers in Christ,

We greet you in the Wonderful Name of Jesus Christ.

It has been a while since we have written; let me bring you up to speed on the work and our doings here in Mozambique. First, Alan was sick for much of the month of September. First there was a stomach problem that required antibiotics to get over. (I think it must have been mad fish) Then in the last part of the month, he was hospitalized with malaria; definitely something NOT to repeat.

In October, we hosted a national preachers meeting for the churches associated with our work. We received 32 preachers from three provinces over a ten day period. Alan taught Bible doctrine and we had daily preaching services. It was a time greatly blessed by God. Five ladies were also able to attend and spent the week with Kathy studying the Bible and going over several ladies' studies that they will be able to pass on to their ladies.

Also in October and part of November we were able to get the work done on our church building in Dondo. The building has drawn a lot of local attention and we have had many visitors over the last few months. We are still waiting approval of our plans for the **Bible Institute building project**. We hope to be able to start the building of the security wall when the rain slacks off in March. We have at present about \$4,100 in our Mission Office account towards the cost of construction. We estimate the cost of phase one to be about \$25,000. We have also **started two mission works**.

The **Container of Bibles** is still in the states but that is due to hold-ups on this end. We have had many delays in the process but hope to be shipping in the next month. We now have a PO Box here where we can receive some mail. If you have doubt about sending something it might be good to contact us first before mailing. The address is:

Our contact information is in the heading of this letter. If you are calling from the USA, remember we are 7 hours ahead of Eastern Time. The Vonage number is a Texas number that rings through to our house in Mozambique.

The truck has been a great blessing but we still owe about \$4,000. We had to have repairs done in December costing about \$900 but it allows Alan and two preachers to travel for most of the **month of January, visiting 14 churches in the Zambezia and Sofala Provinces. Please pray for us.** By the time you receive this letter we will be somewhere on the road. Kathy will be staying at home for this trip due to the rough conditions expected for sleeping and traveling. Pray for souls to be saved and believers to be encouraged.

Pray for us and the work. We know that the battle is the Lord's and that He will bring it to pass! Praise Him! God bless you for your faithfulness to pray for and support the work in Africa.
