

# CHILE

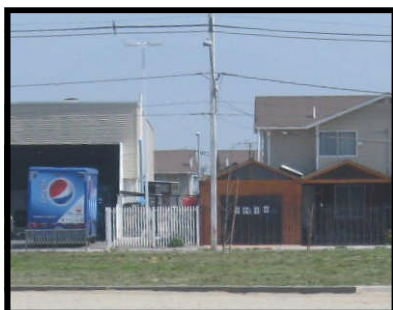

Greetings from Santiago,

November 2011

Exciting things have happened since our last letter in September. I closed that letter asking prayer for the salvation of a new young family, Arturo and Nicole. Barbara and I began our series of Evangelistic Bible studies with them last month and both have since received Christ. They've been so faithful to church since their first visit.

After seven months without a permanent place for our church to meet: under tents,



someone's home and a community center, God opened the door for a location similar to the one we

had before. We are now located on a main divided street with a huge park area in the middle where a "lot" of people come to play and relax. Our building is on the



edge of the parking lot of a new supermarket.

Hundreds from the neighborhood walk by our church location every day, going to and from their homes and the store.

Trinidad is a lady who visited the church before we lost our building in February. A few weeks ago while walking home from the super-

market, she noticed the church and came back with her ten year old son who accepted Christ in S.S. class. She now wants to begin studying the Bible.

You might remember Antonieta from our last letter for inviting Arturo and Nicole. She will begin working with Trinidad using the Evangelistic studies. (We've used those for 25 years to build churches. I have no idea how many people have been saved using those studies.) Antonieta just completed the first level of Discipleship and is very nervous about taking on such a large responsibility involving the two things that are eternal; teaching the Word of God and the soul of a person without Christ. She is also the S.S. teacher who led Trinidad's son to the Lord.

Cristina accepted Christ over a year ago while studying the same Evangelistic studies with Barbara. She was baptized last February and just received her certificate for having completed the first level of Discipleship.
