Dear Pastor and Christian Friends,

My Pastor, Bro. Ben Langley, and I just returned from Ecuador and I wanted to share some of the blessings with you.

The Institute was going great with 26 Students in Sto. Domingo and the 5 professors were doing a wonderful job. The Institute classes are held in another camp and the Missionary is going to donate the camp to the Mission but would like to get some of his money back that was loaned to him. \$20,000 is the amount and the Mission of Ecuador has over half of that amount. We need to raise about \$6,000.00. The camp is valued at \$400,000.00. Would you help us in getting this amount for our Institute?

Two of our Quechua churches are trying to build. One Church needs \$5,000.00 to get their Sunday school building. This Church runs about 200 every Sunday and these are Quechua Indians that live high in the Andes mountain range. The Little children need the building to get out of the rain and cold when attending their Sunday school. That Church has half of the money for that project. Would you help us with this building?

The second Quechua Church is building their building and need some help with the roof. They need about \$4,000.00. Please remember, I am trying to teach these Churches that they will be obligated to help other Churches in the future to get their buildings up. These two Churches have over 6 missions in other areas where they are winning their people to the LORD. Only the Quechuas are invited into these new areas.

Please pray with us about these needs. Thank you for being faithful to Charlene and me. She battles everyday with Parkinson's disease but the LORD is good.
